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**Infrastructure Quebec issues RFQ for a Maintenance facility for railcars**

**(November 22, 2010) Québec, Québec** - Infrastructure Quebec has issued a request for qualifications (RFQ) for a private partner to design, build and finance a new Maintenance facility for the *Agence métropolitaine de transport* (AMT) railcars, to be located in Lachine, Quebec, Canada.

Bidders have until February 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2011 to respond to the RFQ. Infrastructure Quebec plans to qualify a maximum of three shortlisted teams to the request for proposals stage (RFP). The RFP is expected to be issued in Spring 2011.

The project involves the construction, in a turnkey mode, of new maintenance facility for the AMT suburban trains operating on the Canadian Pacific network, comprising a set of buildings and a rail yard.
