2. Project Background, Goals and Objectives

Liberate Yourself is a leader in intimate lifestyle products with a current catalogue of over one-hundred-fifty products. All products come with a five-year unconditional warranty and are manufactured by our trusted manufacturing partners in Ireland. We are currently selling our products via 3rd party retailers across Europe.

Liberate Yourself is now entering the Canadian market by opening seven temporary and five permanent stores across southern Ontario. These locations will be under our brand and will open between August 20, 2018 - September 7, 2018. It is expected that Liberate Yourself will have twenty-one permanent locations by 2023.

Our Customer Demographics:

- Women between the ages of 30 49;
- 64% of users are married;
- Combined household income of \$65,000;
- University educated; and,
- 53% live in metropolitan locations, 47% rural.

Liberate Yourself is seeking the services of a qualified, <u>open-minded and professional</u> web development firm for the design and creation of a new dynamic and modern e-commerce website. This new website will deliver information, invite engagement and showcases our one-hundred-fifty products and outstanding customer service. The proposal is expected to show a clear understanding of the final product and indicate a fixed price for the project completion.

The objectives of the design would provide a website that is:

- a. A comprehensive resource of information for our customers and potential retailers wishing to sell our products;
- b. A channel for online sales;
- d. Easily maintained by IT staff;
- e. Simple to navigate and search;
- f. Compliant with accessibility requirements, specifically WCAG 2.0 Level AA and AODA.

3. New Website Functionality Requirements

The new website will not only be responsive to a variety of mobile devices, but it will provide us with flexibility in terms of posting information in an easy and timely manner. The new e-commerce site will allow for scalability for future uses such as online. Proponents are to recommend a content management system they feel would be appropriate for this website.

4. Proposal Outline

Liberate Yourself is requesting proposals for three services related to the creation of an ecommerce website:

- 1. Professional design and development of an e-commerce website;
- 2. Website hosting and security; and
- 3. Ongoing maintenance and technical support.

Respondents must provide a proposal encompassing all three services. This will be a concept to completion project, from scoping to information architecture, design, development, and deployment.

We are looking for the ongoing maintenance and future redesign requirements of our website to keep it fresh, working well, and secure.

Liberate Yourself will not accept any early designs or mock-ups of the proposed design.

We believe in fair compensation for your time and efforts—not speculative work.

We do ask that you submit three (3) samples of similar work done.

8. Design Requirements

The e-commerce website should have a clean, modern design and users should be able to navigate the site on a variety of devices easily. We welcome innovative ideas to give our website a modern touch; however, the design should be simple, fresh and scalable for future needs. The website should be accessible to all visitors and the proponents should explain in their proposal how they will meet the following design requirements:

- Mobile Friendly - UX / UI Design

- Website Speed - Content Management Solution

- Payment Processor - SEO Optimization

- Site Security - E-commerce

It is expected that the e-commerce website will act as a separate sales channel from our physical locations and POS integrations will not be necessary. Please explain how proposed e-commerce solution can integrate with Sage.

9. Copyright and Intellectual Property

Liberate Yourself will retain the rights to the intellectual property and copyright of all information posted on the new website.

10. Training & Maintenance Requirements

Following a successful website launch, we will require ongoing maintenance, and security support throughout the life of the website. The requests may be related to any aspect of the website but will not include any considerable re-design.

We expect that maintenance and security concerns will be addressed promptly and that the correction or an update on the situation will be provided within hours of the request being sent.

11. Proposal Details

Liberate Yourself will consider proposals based on the overall approach, proposed user-friendly tools, experience of the team, sample work, references, budget, and other criteria. The proposal must be guaranteed for a minimum of 90 days from the closing date of the RFP. Preference will be given to teams with experience working with e-commerce websites.

11.1 Cost of Proposal

Submission of a response to this RFP does not bind Liberate Yourself to engage the firm to provide the requested services. This RFP does not commit Liberate Yourself to pay any costs incurred by any respondents in the submission of a proposal or in making studies or designs for the preparation, or for procuring or contracting for the services to be furnished under the RFP.

11.2 Rejection of Proposals

Liberate Yourself does not guarantee that any proposal will be accepted and reserves the right to reject any or all responses to the RFP without incurring any liability. Submissions received after the due date will be automatically rejected. Incomplete proposals will not be considered.

12. Budget

The budget for the e-commerce website is \$50,000.00 CAD.

The budget for the ongoing support is \$500.00 CAD a month.

13. Proposal Evaluation

Liberate Yourself is seeking a comprehensive proposal from qualified companies to fulfill these objectives. Applicants are expected to show a demonstrated capacity to complete this type of work.

A shortlist of three companies may be selected, contacted and asked to present their company to the Business Development Officer and select members of IT.

Liberate Yourself will evaluate proposals as follows:

- 1. Understanding of proposal and execution plan. (10%)
- 2. Company reputation and references from 3 existing accounts. (20%)
- 3. Pricing and timeline. (35%)
- 4. Plan for ongoing hosting, support and the rate for these services. (35%)

The successful vendor will perform a variety of duties as agreed upon in the final negotiated Service Level Agreement (SLA). The selected vendor and Liberate Yourself will finalize the contract terms and conditions. If Liberate Yourself and the selected vendor are unable to agree on terms and conditions at this point, Liberate Yourself may exercise its right to negotiate with other vendors.
