# Website Redesign & Development

This RFP is for design and development services for a new website for the New York State Association of Independent Schools. Our current website was redesigned in the winter of 2013-14, moving to a responsive design that included an updated interface and a general refresh. Shortly thereafter, our web host introduced a new Ruby on Rails platform, shifting all of their resources to this new, updated product. As our website is approaching 8 years since its introduction and is rendered without an updated platform, we are looking for a full redesign of the site on a new, modern platform capable of integrating with many other services, most notably either FileMaker or <u>MemberSuite</u>.

#### **Company Overview**

NYSAIS is a membership organization of over 200 independent nursery, elementary, and secondary schools, as well as organizations, enrolling over 83,000 students. It is affiliated with the National Association of Independent Schools (NAIS), the New York State Coalition for Independent and Religious Schools, and the International Council Advancing Independent School Accreditation (ICAISA). Founded in 1947, the Association is chartered by the New York State Board of Regents and is incorporated as a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization.
